K-9 teams find driver missing after crash

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. - Neal Archie Davis Jr., 37, was involved in a single-vehicle crash shortly before 8 p.m. Monday, Nov. 22, 2021, near 3092 Bohicket Rd., Johns Island. The car hit a tree and caught fire. Davis was seen fleeing the scene. Since then, he has not been located. The sheriff's helicopter and K-9 units have searched the area. It's unknown if he was injured. Davis has a "Neal" tattoo on the right side of his neck, but his clothing at the time of the crash is unknown. UPDATE Nov. 25, 2021

Deputies found Davis alive around 9:30 this Thanksgiving morning during a search near the crash site. He had left the scene Monday night but could not continue because of his injuries. K-9 units discovered clothing Thursday morning and tracked through the woods as deputies called out. Davis was heard yelling for help nearby. He was removed from the woods and transported to a hospital for treatment of injuries from the crash and exposure to the elements. His injuries are not believed to be life-threatening.
