**NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C.** – Charleston County deputies responded around 10:50 p.m. Friday, Dec. 10, 2021, to a shooting on East Oakridge Circle near North Oakridge Circle in the North Charleston area. They found two male gunshot victims. One suffered a wound that was not life-threatening. The other was seriously wounded after being shot multiple times. Both were taken to area hospitals. A third male who suffered blunt-force injuries also was hospitalized.

Detectives are investigating the circumstances that led to their injuries. No arrests have been made.

## UPDATE Dec. 14, 2021

Detectives are continuing to investigate the circumstances that led to the shooting and are still determining who opened fire. No arrests have been made. There is no information indicating a lingering threat to the broader community.

Responding deputies initially encountered one male who had suffered a gunshot wound to the arm that was not life-threatening. Two more injured males were found. One suffered multiple gunshot wounds but is expected to survive. A third male suffered blunt-force injuries to the head after being struck by an object.
