Arrest in November 2020 shooting

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Deputies from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office today arrested a man wanted in a November 2020 shooting that wounded one person in the McClellanville area.

Jarvis Trymaine Jamison, 33, is being held at the Detention Center on charges of attempted murder and possession of a firearm in the commission of a violent crime.

Deputies responded around 7 p.m. Nov. 24, 2020, to 805 S. Santee Road to a report of a shooting. A man had been shot in the arm, a non-life-threatening injury. During the investigation, detectives gathered information showing the victim had gotten into an argument with Jamison, who pulled out a handgun and shot the victim before fleeing. Warrants were issued in February 2021 for Jamison's arrest.

CCSO Warrants Unit deputies gathered information that led members of the U.S. Marshals Fugitive Task Force to Wilmington, N.C., where Jamison was arrested Jan. 12. He was extradited Friday to face the charges in Charleston County. He is expected to have a bond hearing Saturday.
