Deputies seek leads in Meggett hit-and-run fatality

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Traffic investigators from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office continue to seek information leading to the vehicle that fatally struck a pedestrian last month in the Meggett area.

Deputies responded about 11:30 p.m. Aug. 23 to Highway 165 near Manor Road, where a motorist reported striking a person lying in the road. The motorist rendered aid, but the victim was pronounced dead at the scene.

The victim was later identified as 31-year-old Brandon Hardwick of Meggett.

CCSO's Traffic Services Unit is investigating the crash. Deputies determined that a vehicle struck Hardwick in the road before fleeing the scene. The victim was lying in the road when he was hit by the second vehicle, whose driver stopped and tried to help. That driver called 911 and is not facing charges.

No description of the first vehicle has come to light during the investigation. No arrests have been made.
