Man arrested after West Ashley home invasion

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Deputies from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office responded about 7 a.m. Wednesday to a report of a home invasion on North Dallerton Circle in West Ashley.

It was determined that a man had attempted to carjack victims near a business in the Charleston Police Department's jurisdiction before fleeing to a neighborhood in CCSO's jurisdiction. The man first confronted a juvenile resident with a gun and forced his way into the home, where a total of four children and two adults live. A resident called 911.

The parents got into a confrontation with the intruder. During a struggle, the father forced the man to drop the gun, which the mother took outside with the children. The father forced the man into a room and also went outside with officers already on scene.

CCSO deputies, city police officers and other law enforcement partners responded to the home. The man surrendered after 8 a.m. and was arrested.

The father was treated at the scene for injuries. The suspect was transported to a hospital for treatment of non-life-threatening injuries.

Deangelo Dontrel Brown, 28, was booked later Wednesday at the Al Cannon Detention Center on charges of first-degree burglary, first-degree assault and battery and possession of a firearm during a violent crime. He is expected to have a bond hearing Thursday.
