Man arrested in Johns Island domestic incident

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Deputies arrested a Johns Island man early Saturday morning after a domestic disturbance.

The Charleston County Sheriff's Office responded about 7:30 p.m. Friday to the 2500 block of Bryans Dairy Road after a caller reported that a man had pulled a gun during a domestic dispute involving two family members and threatened to kill them if they tried to leave.

The two victims were able to get out of the home and meet with deputies. They reported that the man had assaulted them, but they were not seriously injured.

Units established a perimeter around the home and attempted to call the man out but got no response.

Additional resources, including CCSO's SWAT team and helicopter, responded to the scene to search the property. About 3:30 a.m., deputies found the man hiding under a tarp in a barn on the property. He was taken into custody without further incident.

Darrell Dickerson, 53, was arrested on charges of domestic violence of a high and aggravated nature, assault and battery of a high and aggravated nature and two counts of kidnapping. He was booked at the Al Cannon Detention Center.
