## Public's help needed in James Island gun theft

**NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C.** – Detectives from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office request the public's assistance in identifying a person seen stealing a firearm from an unlocked vehicle on James Island earlier this month.

Surveillance video around 11:50 p.m. Jan. 14 captured a male subject open the passenger door of a pickup truck on Briarfield Avenue before removing a small handgun from the center console.

The theft was reported the next day after the owner realized the gun was missing and the vehicle had been left unlocked.

Surveillance cameras elsewhere on Briarfield Avenue showed what appeared to be the same male subject walking on the street.
