St. John's firefighter injured in collision

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – The Charleston County Sheriff's Office continues to investigate a crash this morning that injured a St. John's Fire District firefighter.

Deputies responded around 7 a.m. to the collision on U.S. Highway 17 at Davison Road in the Ravenel area. A southbound tractor-trailer collided with a Chevrolet SUV that was turning left onto Highway 17.

The driver of the SUV, a marked St. John's Fire vehicle, was entrapped. Crews quickly extricated the driver, who was transported to MUSC with serious injuries.

The tractor-trailer driver was not injured.

Both were wearing a seat belt.

The fire SUV was not responding to a call at the time of the crash. An initial investigation indicates the tractor-trailer had disregarded a red light. Deputies from CCSO's Traffic Bureau are still investigating the crash.
