Teenager shot in hand in Hollywood area

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Deputies from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office are continuing to investigate after a 17-year-old was shot in the hand Saturday in the Hollywood area.

The male victim showed up after 8 p.m. at a fire station on Highway 174. EMS then transported him to MUSC for treatment of a non-life-threatening gunshot wound to his left hand.

The victim stated he had been walking on Highway 162 when he heard gunshots and felt the injury. He told deputies that he then got a ride to the fire station.

Deputies found evidence of a shooting along Highway 162 west of the Highway 165 intersection.
