Two hurt in stabbing; suspect arrested

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Around 4:50 p.m. today, deputies from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office responded to a reported stabbing in the 7500 block of Tedder Street in the North Charleston area. They found two victims who had stab wounds that were not life-threatening. They were transported to a local hospital.

Other responding deputies, meanwhile, found a man who matched the attacker's description at a nearby convenience store. The suspect, Christopher Lewis Rawls, 22, was arrested on charges of attempted murder and assault and battery of a high and aggravated nature. He was taken to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

The victims reported that the suspect was a stranger. The reason for the attack was not immediately known. Detectives continue to investigate.
