CCSO detention deputy injured in assault

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – A Charleston County detention deputy is recovering at home following an assault early Friday morning at the Al Cannon Detention Center.

The assault was reported shortly after midnight Aug. 4, when a detention resident attacked the deputy in a housing unit. The deputy lost consciousness during the assault. He was taken to MUSC for treatment of serious injuries. He was released later in the day.

The victim, Master Detention Deputy Reynolds Reeves, has been with CCSO since December 2017.

CCSO deputy sheriffs charged Kalif Ja'Corey Mungin, 19, with attempted murder in connection with the assault.

Mungin has been held at the Detention Center since November on various CCSO charges related to a shooting. More on that case:
