Teen injured in shooting in McClellanville area

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – The Charleston County Sheriff's Office is investigating a shooting that injured a 17-year-old boy early Tuesday in the McClellanville area.

Deputies responded about 12:30 a.m. to the 8400 block of Old Georgetown Road and located the wounded teenager. The deputies tended to his injuries until EMS arrived and took him to a local hospital. His injuries were believed to be serious but not life-threatening.

Preliminary information indicated that the victim had been in a vehicle when someone opened fire, striking him.

Members of the U.S. Marshals Service fugitive task force on Thursday arrested Eric Shamarr Manigualt, 25, of Awendaw on charges of attempted murder and possession of a weapon during a violent crime in connection with this shooting. Upon his arrest, he was found in possession of drugs, prompting a charge of possession of cocaine base. He was booked at the Al Cannon Detention Center, where he continues to be held on the charges.
